Eligibility:

Full-time students who are enrolled to begin classes at Pittsburgh Institute of Aeronautics - Hagerstown or Myrtle Beach Campuses.

Evaluation of Applications:

Only applications at least one month prior to the subsequent semester will be considered. Eligible applications are evaluated by the Scholarship Selection Committee based on level of financial need, academic and attendance record, completeness and presentation of the application, level of involvement in school/work/extracurricular activities, and overall quality of the short essays. An appropriate number of scholarship finalists will be chosen by the Scholarship Selection Committee, based on the results of the application evaluation process, and the number of awards available.

Finalist Interviews:

Finalists will receive notification of their status and will be required to appear for an interview with members of the Scholarship Selection Committee. Branch campus interviews will be held via teleconference. Finalists may be evaluated based on financial need, educational need, and overall quality of responses provided during the Interview. Scholarship recipients will receive notification of their award.

Program Participation Notes and Requirements:

Student Teams will consist of up to four students. One student per semester will be assigned as lead for that toolbox. The box will be signed out for use. The lead is responsible for inventorying and signing the box complete. Any missing items require immediate accountability to locate the item(s). The lead must present the box to the instructor to verify all tools are present.

Participants will be required to sign an agreement which outlines a student's responsibilities for participation in the program. Students selected for this program should contact the Campus Director to discuss details of the program prior to participating.

Some employers require technicians to be equipped with their own tools. Therefore, we urge all students to budget for personal tools before they begin seeking a job, even if participating in this program.

While the Piedmont Airlines Tools for Success program supplies the majority of required tools for the Aviation Maintenance Technology program, I must purchase additional tools to meet the PIA minimal tool list requirement.
